Karen Hilborn Crabtree 1. Call the center at least 24 hours in advance to schedule your transportation. Also call 24 hours in advance if you need to cancel your reservation.

2. If for some reason you are not able to attend on a day that you have made a reservation, you must call and cancel your reservation 24 hours in advance. Please call as soon as you know that you will not be able to attend. The Center has an answering service for your convenience. This will allow another member on the waiting list to fill your spot on the bus that day.

- 3. You must be waiting when the bus arrives. Our pickups are between 8:00 and 9:00 a.m. Our drivers will not ring your doorbell or call to remind you that you made a reservation. This is a courtesy to your fellow bus riders and allows us to stay on schedule to have everyone at the center before 9:30 a.m.
- 4. You should be ready to leave the center at approximately 12:30 p.m. when the bus arrives. Our drivers will not look for you.

Three violations of the center's transportation policy will result in a two-week suspension from riding the Center bus. This policy is consistent with the Frankfort Transit Bus Service. Once again, this policy is designed to provide all center members equal access to our free transportation services.

Donations are accepted for our transportation services to keep the buses running. Thank you!
